- Emphasize the importance of a committed Transition Team *utilizing the Student Centered Model* to Explore Career Opportunities and Receive a post secondary education.

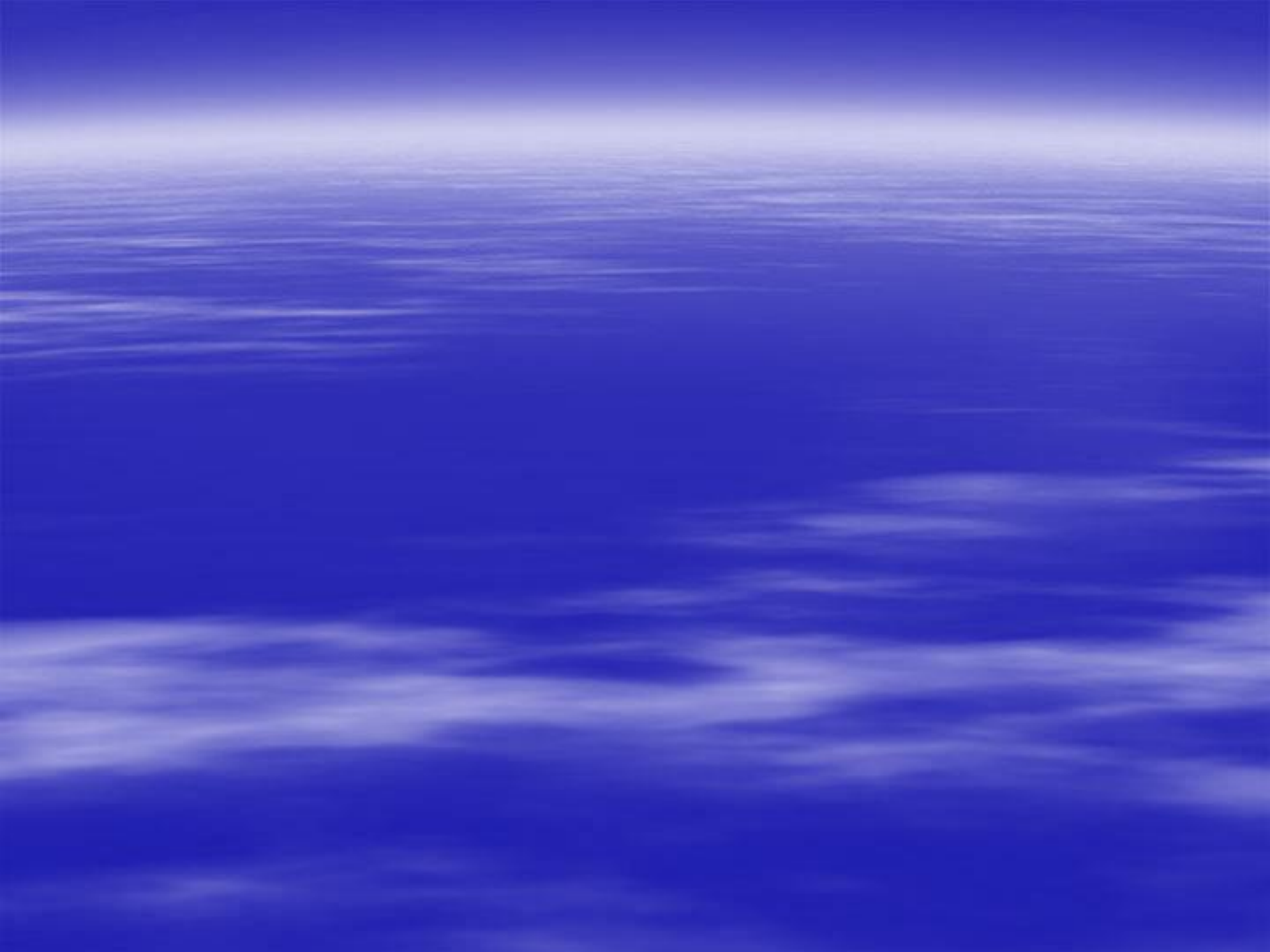

My Journey through School.....

Elementary-Mill Creek (1994-2000)

- Regular curriculum
- PT/OT/Speech
- Vacation: Homework/Tutoring-Montessori method

Middle-Tates Creek (2000-2003)

- Front row seat, large font texts, extra time for tests and set of text books for home.
- I had 2 hours of private tutoring daily

Tates Creek High School

2003-2007 (9-12)

- **All accommodations from Middle school were continued.**
- **Scantron for test taking was eliminated.**
- **Private tuition: Daily for 2 hours**
- **Graduation: June, 2007 with High School Diploma**
GPA 3.75; Governors Scholar for 4 years !

- Guest Speaker Advocating for persons with Intellectual disabilities to be in Inclusive classrooms, Post Secondary Education and Employment

Accommodations @ BCTCS (2007-2013)

Special Ed department notified instructor:

- **Extra time for tests (double the regular time)**
- **Use of Scantron for tests eliminated**
- **Notes/ tests provided in large font**
- **Academic Support service provided by OVR**

(Academic coach attended class, took notes and provided tutoring).

College Experience BCTCS 2007-2013

- **Enrolled in the Fall of 2007**
- **Required Remedial classes in Math and English.**
- **Changed major from OTA to Para Educator.**
- **This decision resulted in extra course work!**
- **Graduated Spring 2013 with Honors-GPA 3.70!**

- **Graduate from College with my Associates Degree in Education**
- **Get a Paid Job as a Para Educator!**
- **Get my Driver's License!**

Update on my Independent Living Skills

- **Driver's License -December 27, 2013.**
 - OVR provided Driver Instruction Services
 - Modified Mom's vehicle to meet my needs.
- **Live in my own apartment modified for my needs.**
- **Services provided by M-P waiver under Medicaid.**
 - Home making skills/money management.
 - Respite services

Employment

- Supported Employment - OVR/ M-P waiver.
 - Job Coach assigned to me.
 - Assistance with developing Resume,
 - Assistance with interview skills.
 - Apply for positions in Elementary/Pre school program as a Para Educator.

Employment History...

- August 2013 - June, 2015: After School Program Picadome Elementary School.
- July, 2014 – August 2015: Lunch Monitor at SP&P, pre school program AND Counselor, After school program.
- August 2015-Present: Counselor, Afterschool Program at Meadowthorpe Elementary.
 - Supervise KG/First grade students.

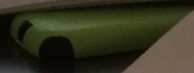
Glimpse into the Future

...Education Re assessed!

- **Enrolled at BCTC to obtain Associates certificate as a Para Educator in General Education – Completed, Fall 2014.**
- **Transferred all my credits and enrolled at UK to obtain Bachelor's Degree in Special Education with a major in Learning Behavior Disorders-Fall 2014.**
- **I have completed 80 credit hours and have a GPA of 3.23**

My story as it relates to education and our role in improving education for persons with disabilities

- Elementary – Inclusion and Individualized Education plan (IEP)
 - Middle school: challenges- Bullying and my inability to defend myself!
 - High school- Committed Transition Planning Team which was Person centered and designed with my interest in going to college
- Goal: Associate degree as a Certified Occupational Therapy Assistant (COTA) and then switched my major to education



Glimpse into the Future...

- I am taking only one or two classes per semester because I know employment is important.
- I intend to continue in my job so I can improve my skills working with children.
- I not only help students one on one with their home work, I now supervise large group activities with the First Graders-I really enjoy working with them!

- **A Positive Attitude, Honesty and Loyalty!**

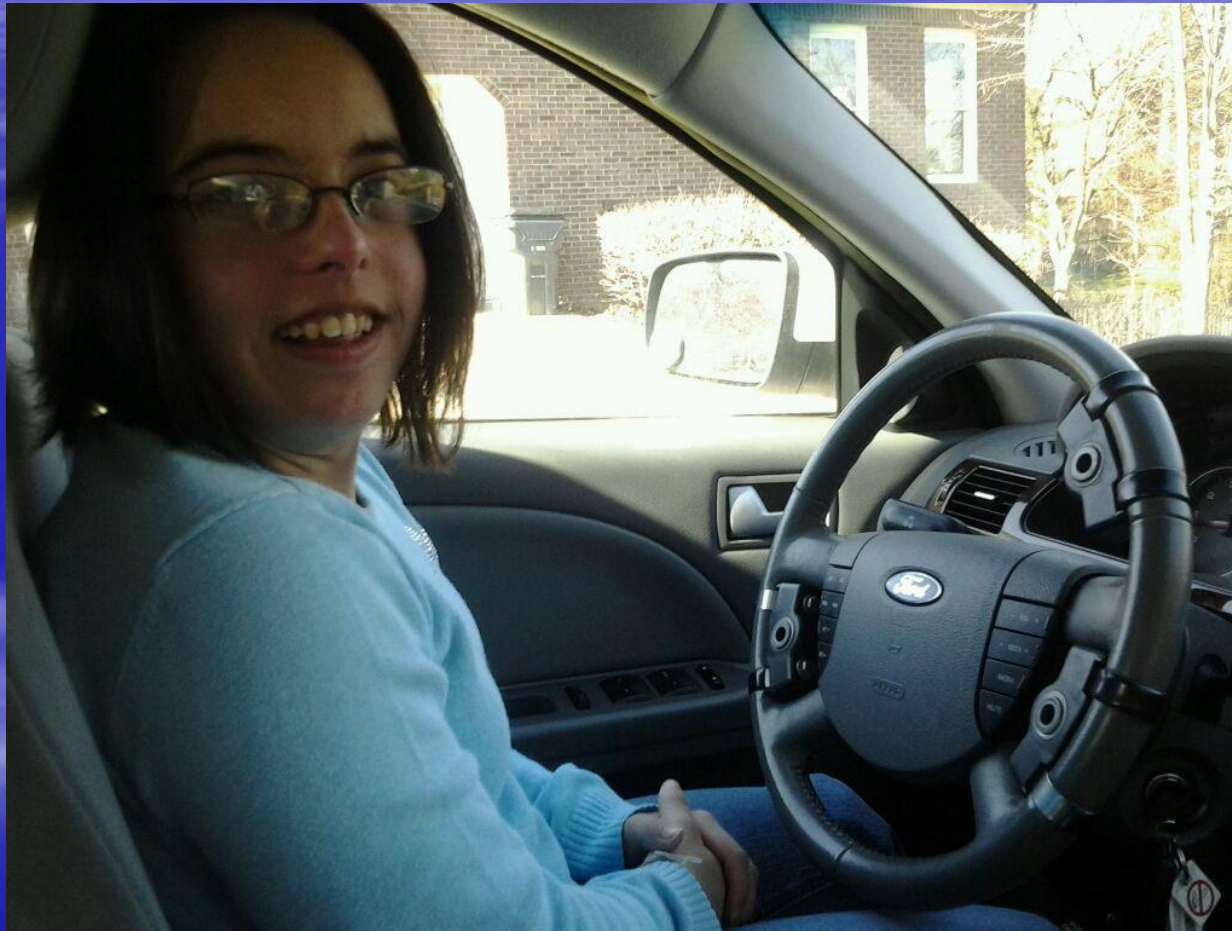
Employer/Co workers:
