- A process to get to know someone
- SPEND time with someone rather than testing
- The best way to find what someone has to offer an employer
- Get to know people in the settings where they are most who they are
- A way that you can identify unique qualities and skills they can offer an employer.
- Foundation for job development
- Matches job applicant with jobs that make sense

How do I begin Discovery?

- Review information on consumer
- Identify places to go with the consumer
 - Build on these activities
- With the consumers permission Identify people in their life to talk too
- Each activity is individualized based on the consumer

What is the first rule of Discovery?

Do not ask the consumer what type job they want?
