Target Audience – Case Managers and Employment Specialists/ Medicaid Waiver providers who bill supported employment Topics - This session will cover supported employment expectations – service delivery, paperwork, and billing – under Michelle P. and SCL Waivers. We will also provide a brief overview of Supported Employment expectations under Vocational Rehabilitation.

Presenters will include representatives from: Office of Vocational Rehabilitation, Division of Developmental and Intellectual Disabilities and UK-HDI's Supported Employment Training Project.
